Observation

- Militants are individualists.
- They only think about defending their rights.
- They are enclosed in consumer society.
- In reality they are activists, that is to say citizens wanting to be in a group to unbuild society.
- Indeed, the students only learn to unbuild society.







Observation (continued)

- Really, militancy is deteriorated by liberalism, an ideology present everywhere in media.
- Liberalism consists to say that the individual makes society.
- The consumer society promotes the short term, individualism demanding rights without including society.
- Thus, activists' demands are not linked to society.
- So, the politicians agree with a hierarchy,
 an individualist activist, therefore, thinking about their advantages.



Possibility

- Using greatest thinkers' examples, we can start writing poems first to understand ourselves, then political writings about the great thinkers like Plato, Leibniz, Henry Charles Carey, Planck, Einstein, Lyndon Larouche.
- These thinkers have made politics and give an opinion on politics.

- He meets with non-mediatized political groups because they are crucial.
- The militant campaigns for the general interest, which adds new rights.
- He knows that the individual interest is corruptible.

What is the general interest?

- The general interest use the current society's economy.
- It improves society in order to adapt it to a future full of new rights.
- It allows disruptive technologies not used, because they require a public currency.
- It asks to campaign to establish a productive public currency, a currency that
 makes it possible to provide money to productive citizens, production then
 increasing to export and have a trade surplus with other countries.
- Then new rights can be created.

What is the general interest?

- However, we can introduce new rights without waiting, for a better future.
- For example, education through multiple intelligences and creativity makes it possible to create geniuses at school.
- Thus the creative student gets society and transforms it well.
- But the general interest requires to be ethical and clear about that we want to do.

Why write?

- When we listen, we keep little of what we listen to. Listening is mainly used to filter. It is an oral consumption that does not allow to grow.
- When we read, we retain half of what is read. We are still in consumption.
- When we write, we retain almost everything we write, because we build. So we're growing.



What to write?

- We write about our future and how to become free.
- We write workshops to show an ideal future.
- We then look for that is missing from this future so that it should become ideal.
- We then find that it is the energy that makes the economy, which the fourth generation power plants make it possible to reindustrialize to build the future.



Become a scientist, an artist, a philosopher.

- The higher hypothesis is used to determine nature's laws. When a superior hypothesis defeats all of our hypotheses, we have to check if it is true.
- So we keep this upper hypothesis and we grow.
- For this, it is about philosophizing and writing poems, songs.
- We may think that this is a long time coming. But the higher hypothesis is not often found and turns everything upside down.

Use your brain

- After having determined our intelligences, we know what we can be placed on.
